Singing	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing songs from a variety of styles, genres and cultures. • Sing echo songs. • Show melody direction up or down or the same. • Respond to high or low sounds with hand signals. • Sing easy texts with clear enunciation. • Grow in pitch and rhythm, accuracy and togetherness.
Playing	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play boomwhackers and simple percussion instruments. • Play simple rhythms with rhythm instruments and kazoos. • Keep a beat on various rhythm instruments. • Experiment with glockenspiels and xylophones.
Movement	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move when music begins and stop when it ends. • Perform actions to songs. • Run, skip, gallop and do circle dances to music. • Freely move to music with bean bags and scarves.
Rhythm	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Echo a rhythm pattern. • Clap recurring rhythms in songs. • Perform a beat in various tempos with body percussion (clap, snap, pat, etc.).
Reading Music	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read stick notation and play or clap its rhythms. • Introduce the music alphabet.
Listening	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hear music from various styles, genres and cultures. • Hear music with and without voices and instruments. • Identify common sounds. • Follow directions while performing action songs. • Enjoy listening to books about music and sing-along books. • Hearing and comparing instruments of the orchestra.
