

<p><u>Through the power of the Holy Spirit working through God's Word, students completing grade two instruction will be able to:</u></p>	
	<p>Understand God's plan of salvation; God sent His Son Jesus to earth to live, suffer, die, rise again, and ascend into heaven to prepare a place for all believers in Christ. Jesus will return again to gather His followers to heaven.</p>
	<p>Through faith, believe they are saved by grace and not by works.</p>
	<p>Through the study of Old Testament and New Testament Bible stories, see God's plan of salvation develop.</p>
	<p>Know that the Holy Spirit works through God's Word and the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper.</p>
	<p>Know and understand the meaning of the word sacrament.</p>
	<p>Understand that God calls them to be His children through baptism.</p>
	<p>Remember the Savior when the Lord's Supper is celebrated. Know the Lord's Supper is a sacrament, which consists of the bread and wine and the promise of God's forgiveness.</p>
	<p>Identify the Trinity as one God and understand the work of each person of the Trinity.</p>
	<p>Grow in their personal relationship with God through daily devotions, study of God's Word, prayer and worship.</p>
	<p>Through the power of the Holy Spirit learn to share the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus, in their own words and actions.</p>
	<p>Through the power of the Holy Spirit, acknowledge that they are sinners needing forgiveness. Learn to</p>

	that they are sinners needing forgiveness. Learn to admit sin and receive forgiveness for it.
	Understand that Christ shows them how to fight the devil and his temptations with God's Word.
	Through the power of the Holy Spirit, be able to share forgiveness when another has hurt them through word or deed.
	Through prayer see God's work in their lives and in others' lives.
	Understand the meaning of the word worship and how to worship in their own lives.
	Develop a devotion or worship service for chapel.
	Share God's gifts with others through service projects and mission offerings
	Learn prayers, songs, Bible verses, and creeds to praise God for His many blessings and to express and be a witness to their faith.
	Begin to develop an understanding of how God works through history in studying the role of Martin Luther in reforming the church.
