<u>The students will be able to:</u>	
	Express awe and wonder at God's creation.
	Acknowledge that Abraham received God's promise through faith, not through works or self-worthiness.
	Identify the Ten Commandments.
	Confess their sins, confident in God's forgiveness in Christ Jesus.
	Praise and worship God with their songs, prayers, gifts, and lives of service.
	Recognize that God helps them overcome problems in unexpected ways.
	Demonstrate a desire to come to God in prayer regularly and often, confident that their loving Father hears their prayers.
	Praise God for the worth He gives them in Christ.
	Thank God for the blessings of Christian friends.
	Express a desire to love and forgive all others.
	Demonstrate a desire to share the Gospel with others.
	Express trust in God to care for their physical and spiritual needs.
	Describe God's plan to send a Savior.
	Describe and appreciate the work and blessings of the Holy Spirit.
	Acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God, yet true man and Savior of the world.
	Profess that Jesus physically rose from the dead.
	Explain that Jesus will return to earth to judge the world and take them to heaven.
	Locate and read Bible verses from the Bible.
	Identify the blessings of the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper.
	Acknowledge that only by God's grace are they empowered to do His will.
	Identify the difference between Law and Gospel.
