Teaching Objectives/Learner Outcomes

Overall Summary of Subject: Religion

Students at Timothy Lutheran School receive a Christ-centered and Scripture-based religious instruction so that students, with the power of the Holy Spirit, grow spiritually. Such instruction will help students to:

Grow in their personal relationship with and walk with Christ through worship, study of God's Word, prayer and the sacraments.

Understand God's plan for salvation, sending Jesus to die for them, rise again, and return for judgment.

Understand that God's forgiveness, love, and the gift of eternal life cannot be earned, but are given by the grace of God.

Accept God's Word, the Bible, as true and without error.

Know that the Holy Spirit works through God's Word and the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper.

Know that the Trinity is one God: God the Father, Creator; God the Son, Redeemer; God the Holy Spirit, Sanctifier.

Rely on the Holy Spirit to help them develop Christian relationships with peers, family, teachers, and others.

Grow to give and accept forgiveness.

Share the Gospel with their words, actions, prayers and gifts.

Discern right from wrong, using God's Word as a guide.

Praise and thank God individually and in corporate worship.

Know that they are part of God's creation, fearfully and wonderfully made.

Express praise and acknowledge God's work of creation.

Accept and understand the Christian's responsibility for taking care of God's creation.

- 3. Identify the Trinity as one God and understand the work of each person of the Trinity.**
- 4. Grow in their personal relationship with God through daily devotions, study of God's Word, prayer and worship.**
- 5. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, learn to share the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus, in their own words and actions.**
- 6. Through the power of the Holy Spirit acknowledge that they are sinners needing forgiveness. Learn to admit sin and receive forgiveness for it.**
- 7. Through the power of the Holy Spirit be able to share forgiveness when another has hurt them through word or deed.**
- 8. Through prayer see God's work in their own lives and in others' lives.**
- 9. Learn that they are fearfully and wonderfully made. They have a responsibility to take care of the life God has given to them.**
- 10. Learn that as Christians they have a privilege and responsibility to take care of God's creation.**
- 11. Share God's gifts with others through service projects and mission offerings.**
- 12. Learn prayers, songs, and Bible verses to praise God for His many blessings and to express and be a witness to their faith.**

Grade 2

- 1. Understand God's plan of salvation; God sent His Son Jesus to earth to live, suffer, die, rise again, and ascend into heaven to prepare a place for all believers in Christ. Jesus will return again to gather His followers to heaven.**
- 2. Through faith, believe they are saved by grace and not by works.**
- 3. Through the study of Old Testament and New Testament Bible stories, see God's plan of salvation develop.**
- 4. Know that the Holy Spirit works through God's Word and the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper.**
- 5. Know and understand the meaning of the word sacrament.**
- 6. Understand that God calls them to be His children through baptism.**
- 7. Remember the Savior when the Lord's Supper is celebrated. Know the Lord's Supper is a sacrament, which consists of the bread and wine and the promise of God's forgiveness.**
- 8. Identify the Trinity as one God and understand the work of each person of the Trinity.**
- 9. Grow in their personal relationship with God through daily devotions, study of God's Word, prayer and worship.**
- 10. Through the power of the Holy Spirit learn to share the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus, in their own words and actions.**

Grade 3	The students will be able to... <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Express awe and wonder at God's creation.2. Acknowledge that Abraham received God's promise through faith, not through works or self-worthiness.3. Identify the Ten Commandments.4. Confess their sins, confident in God's forgiveness in Christ Jesus.5. Praise and worship God with their songs, prayers, gifts, and lives of service.6. Recognize that God helps them overcome problems in unexpected ways.7. Demonstrate a desire to come to God in prayer regularly and often, confident that their loving Father hears their prayers.8. Praise God for the worth He gives them in Christ.9. Thank God for the blessings of Christian friends.10. Express a desire to love and forgive all others.11. Demonstrate a desire to share the Gospel with others.12. Express trust in God to care for their physical and spiritual needs.13. Describe God's plan to send a Savior.14. Describe and appreciate the work and blessings of the Holy Spirit.15. Acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God, yet true man and Savior of the world.16. Profess that Jesus physically rose from the dead.17. Explain that Jesus will return to earth to judge the world and take them to heaven.18. Recite the Apostles' Creed19. Recite Luther's Morning and Evening Prayers.20. Recite the Lord's Prayer.21. Memorize and reflect about various Bible verses.22. Locate and read Bible verses from the Bible.23. Identify the blessings of the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper.24. Acknowledge that only by God's grace are they empowered to do His will.25. Identify the difference between Law and Gospel.

Grade 4	<p>A. Relationship with God:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Identify the attributes of God.2. Identify Jesus as the only way to heaven.3. Acknowledge that Jesus, the Savior, is both true God and true man.4. Define the terms <u>grace</u> and <u>faith</u>.5. Discuss the four elements of prayer: confession, adoration, supplication, and thanksgiving.6. Evidence a desire for the spiritual food offered through God's Word.7. Confess their sins to God, trusting that He will forgive them because of His Son, Jesus.8. Acknowledge that at Easter Jesus proclaimed His victory over sin, death, and the power of the devil.9. Realize that God gives them faith so that they may live as His children. <p>B. Relationship with others:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pray for God's guidance in building Christian relationships.2. Acknowledge that God desires all people to receive eternal life and salvation.3. Express their love for God in acts of forgiveness and service towards others.4. Witness the Christian faith in their daily lives.5. Acknowledge the communion of saints as a special blessing from God. <p>C. Relationship with the world:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Thank God for His creating and preserving might.

Grade 5	<p>A. Relationship with God:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Recognize Law and Gospel.2. Identify grace as the motivation for good works.3. Compare and contrast Luther's views and the teachings of the 16th-century church.4. Acknowledge Holy Scripture as the final authority for both doctrine and practice.5. Define worship.6. Acknowledge Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ who fulfilled Old Testament prophecies.7. Recognize that through the means of grace, the Holy Spirit leads people to identify and trust in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.8. Daily remember the covenant God made with them in Baptism.9. Express confident trust in God to help them overcome the temptations they face. <p>B. Relationship with others:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Acknowledge that through His suffering and death, Jesus earned forgiveness of sin and eternal life for them and for all people.2. Rely on the Holy Spirit's power to share God's love and forgiveness with all others. <p>C. Relationship with the world:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Recognize signs of God's love and care in their own lives.2. Identify opportunities in which God can use them in service to Him.3. Trust that God will accomplish His good purposes even in times of conflict and crisis.
